

## Cookie Statement Intrrow

### 1. Introduction

In offering and through the use of our services, products and information through our application or any other platform (collectively referred to as the "**Platform**") as well as when using our website [www.intrrow.io](http://www.intrrow.io) (hereinafter the "**Website**"), Intrrow BV (hereinafter referred to as "**Intrrow**", "**we**", "**us**", "**our**") will allow the placement of certain cookies on the device of the user / visitor (hereinafter "**you**", "**your**").

The platform and Website are operated by Intrrow BV, with registered office at Poel 16, 9000 Ghent, Belgium and with company and VAT number (BE)0798.161.431.

Intrrow will do its utmost best to answer any question or concern as soon as possible, and always within the boundaries of applicable laws.

### 2. General information

The present cookie statement (hereinafter referred to as the "**Cookie Statement**") describes the different types of cookies we use on the Platform and Website as well as your rights in relation to the use of cookies.

We have strict procedures on privacy and we are committed to being transparent about the technologies used on our Platform and Website. To the extent that the information collected by cookies contains personal data, the provisions of the [Privacy Statement](#) apply and complement the Cookie Statement.

### 3. Some more information about cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is placed by a server in your browser or on your computer's hard drive or on your mobile device when you consult the Platform and/or the Website. Cookies are used to distinguish you from other users of the Platform and/or the Website.

First-party cookies are cookies that are used by the visited Platform and/or the Website itself. Third-party cookies are cookies that do not originate from the Platform and/or the Website itself, but from another website or platform.

Session cookies are cookies that automatically disappear when you end your session on our Platform and/or the Website. Persistent cookies, on the other hand, do not disappear immediately but only after a certain period of time.

The use of strictly necessary cookies is not subject to your consent, but through this Cookie Statement we want to inform you of the use of these cookies on the Platform and/or the Website. However, for non-strictly necessary cookies (such as cookies used for analysis, performance, etc.) we ask your explicit consent via the cookie banner incorporated on the Platform and/or the Website. You can choose to accept or deny all cookies (except for the strictly necessary ones).

Your consent can be revoked at all times. Further on in this Cookie Statement we explain how you can do this easily.

#### 4. Which cookies are used on the Website and the Platform?

We use different types of cookies on the Website and the Platform, for the following purposes:

##### 4.1. List of strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for browsing our Website or Platform or strictly necessary for providing a service specifically requested/expected by a user. It is therefore not possible to delete these types of cookies. You do not need to provide your consent with these cookies, but we want to inform you about these nonetheless. If you do not agree to the use of these cookies, you may/can not use the Website or Platform, as the case may be.

Strictly necessary cookies used on the **Website and Platform**:

- **Cloudflare**: Content delivery network. Cloudflare places a cookie which is used to identify individual clients behind a shared IP address and apply security settings on a per-client basis. More information: <https://www.cloudflare.com/privacypolicy/>

Strictly necessary cookies used on the **Platform**:

Name	Duration	Content and purpose
__secure-next-auth.session-token	30 seconds	A signed session JWT token that's used to authenticate every action performed by the user. Refreshes every 30 seconds
__secure-next-auth.callback-url	Session	Callback URL utilised after authentication to redirect the user.
__host-next-auth.csrf-token	Session	CSRF-token to prevent Cross-Site Request Forgery.

##### 4.2. Functional cookies

Functional cookies allow certain functionalities to be executed. You can disable these types of cookies, but please note that in this case you will not be able to use certain functionalities. For an optimal browsing and/or user experience, we advise you to enable these cookies.

This type of cookies makes the functioning of our website and apps easier and ensures a personalized browsing experience by, for example, remembering login names, passwords and preferences - such as the language setting. As a user, you can request which functional cookies are used by Introuw BV by going to the cookie settings on the website.

##### 4.3. List of analytical cookies

Analytical cookies are used to understand how our visitors and users interact with the Website and/or Platform, as the case may be. These cookies allow us to collect information on certain metrics such as number of users, which website our users come from, which pages / functionalities are frequently visited, etc. You can disable these types of cookies.

Analytical cookies used on the **Website and Platform**:

- **Google Analytics**: Collects anonymous data about the use of our website and compiles visitor statistics. More information: <https://www.google.com/intl/nl/policies/privacy/partners/>.
- **HubSpot**: HubSpot tracks visitors using browser cookies. Every time a visitor lands on your website, HubSpot will check for an existing tracking cookie. If one does not exist, a cookie will be associated with that visitor and will log every page that person visits moving forward. More information: <https://legal.hubspot.com/privacy-policy>
- **Hotjar**: A technology service that helps us better understand our users' experience (e.g. how much time they spend on which pages, which links they choose to click, what

users do and don't like, etc.). Hotjar uses cookies and other technologies to collect data on our users' behavior and their devices. This includes a device's IP address, device screen size, device type, browser information, geographic location (country only). #### 4.4. Advertising cookies
